The 2027 Arts BC Provincial Conference will bring 200 delegates to Surrey, including 100 visitors from outside the Lower Mainland.

The event is expected to generate approximately \$263,000 in total economic impact through spending on accommodations, restaurants, cafés, local transportation, retail, entertainment, and conference services sourced from Surrey businesses.

In addition to these direct economic benefits, the conference will showcase Surrey's vibrant arts and cultural community to leaders from across British Columbia, fostering new partnerships, future visitation, and increased visibility for the city as a destination for cultural tourism and provincial events.
