Community Cultural Forums are designed to be day-long sessions of learning (think: mini-conference) tailored to your arts and culture community's needs.

Topics include, but are not limited to:

- Engagement in the Arts: Directions

Fees include: speaker fees, venue rental charges (where applicable), and travel costs depending on location.
